The Heart of Ohio Trail is a paved shady 15.5-mile trail that follows the path of the former Cleveland, Akron & Columbus Railroad from Centerburg to Mount Vernon. Cyclists, hikers, runners, and cross-country skiers return to this scenic rural trail to experience nature in all seasons. There are several handicap accessible trail access points along the trail.

VISIT OUR TRAIL TOWNS

CENTERBURG

Centerburg sits at the geographic center of Ohio. Exit the trail at Clayton Street and head to the center of the village. Centerburg is typical small town Ohio. It is home to several small shops and a variety of places to grab a bite to eat.

MOUNT VERNON

Mount Vernon is at the northernmost point of the trail. Head a few blocks north on Main Street to explore one of Ohio’s best hometowns. The downtown offers a nice collection of shops, restaurants, and historic buildings.

TRAIL ETIQUETTE

The Heart of Ohio Trail is shared by walkers, cyclists, runners, and others. Please be considerate of others and follow these guidelines for a safe enjoyable visit.

- Obey posted rules and regulations.
- Respect private property.
- Don’t litter.
- Clean up after your pet.
- Keep to your right.
- Pass with caution to your left.
- Give warning when you pass.
- Bicyclists yield to all other users.
- Move off trail when stopped.
- Obey all traffic and trail signs.



The Heart of Ohio Trail is part of the Knox County Park District. The trail is a segment of the Ohio to Erie Trail that crosses the state of Ohio from Cincinnati to Cleveland.
