

Fairy Blossoms at Hellbender

Join us in our fairy garden contest by submitting a garden entry. 15 or more designs will be selected for placement on our Fairy Trail to be located at Hellbender Preserve, 23316 Coshocton Road, Howard.

Requirements

1. Choose an oval, round or square flower pot no larger than 24" in diameter to create your design. If selected, your design will be transplanted at Hellbender Preserve (you will leave everything but the pot).
2. Choose from the following plants to decorate your pot, ferns, mosses, Virginia creeper, miniature hostas, lichens, milkweed, prickly pear, spring beauty, wild strawberry, yucca, or violets. (NO INVASIVE PLANTS ARE PERMITTED). Please do not remove these plants from a park or natural area. We suggest you purchase from a local nursery/greenhouse or remove the plant(s) from your yard. The Park District has the right to exclude entries that do not meet the plant criteria.
3. All accessories must be as natural as possible. No glue or any substance is permitted which might be harmful to the wildlife. Be creative and look at the natural surroundings such as trees, stumps, logs, rocks, etc. at the Hellbender site.

Steps Involved

1. Register your entry at our website www.knoxcountyparks.org and click on the Activities link and select "register your entry."
2. Visit Hellbender Preserve (first come, first serve) to locate numbered areas of selected locations. Choose **three** possible locations for your fairy garden. Take photos of the locations with the stake numbers and email them to katiehux@knoxcountyparks.org and include your name.
3. Design your garden and submit a photo of the design to katiehux@knoxcountyparks.org **Include a very short creative story of your design (this story will appear as a QR code for the visitors to read).**
4. All entries must be submitted by June 14th.
5. Winning entries will be selected on June 17 and participants will be notified.
6. Entries must be in place on June 24th at Hellbender Preserve.
7. The new trail will launch on June 25 and run through September 25
